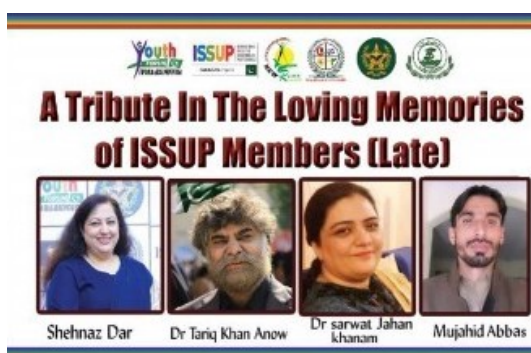
CICAD-ISSUP Round Table

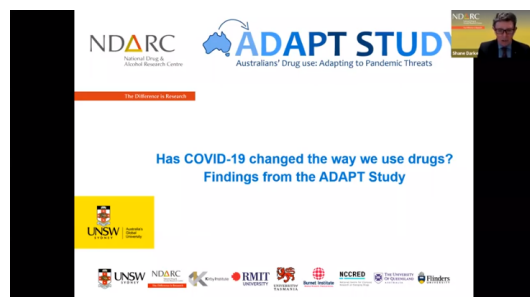
