We dedicate this edition to overdose awareness and hope you enjoy the range of resources on offer, including the latest [ISSUP Reading List](#) on overdose recognition and management.

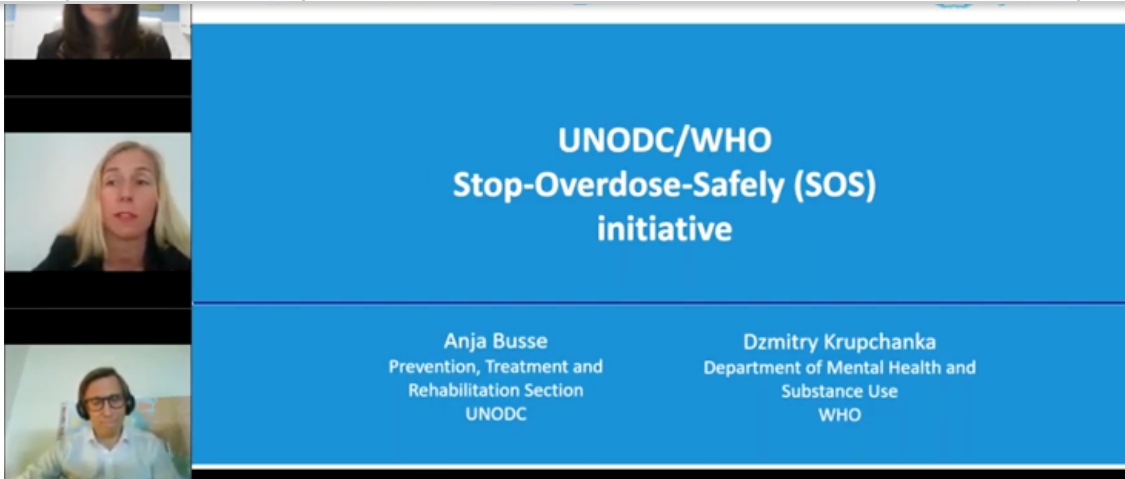
International Overdose Awareness Day webinar recording

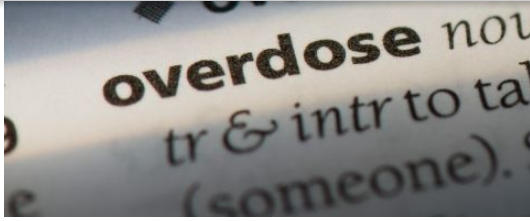

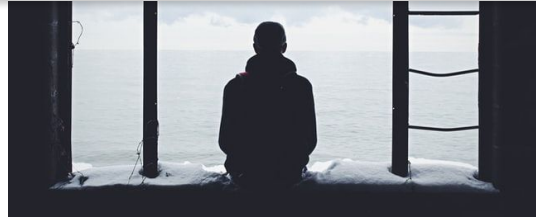
