Events Entry Requirements for Domestic Participants (UAE Residents)

Vaccination is no longer a requirement in order to access events at ADNEC.

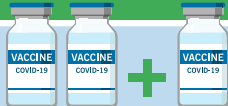

Participants should present AlHosn App green pass at all entry points in the venue

The green pass is granted for



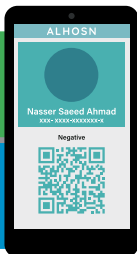
- Those who received two doses of the vaccine (up to 6 months).
- Those who received a booster dose after 6 months from their second dose.



Participants in clinical trials

Participants must provide that no more than **6 months** have passed since the second dose and **3 months** have passed for the most vulnerable groups of the elderly and those with chronic diseases

Vaccinated participants only need to present **Green Pass** to enter events.

Non-vaccinated participants need to present a negative PCR test result conducted in the UAE, and valid for no more than **96 hours** prior entrance to the event.

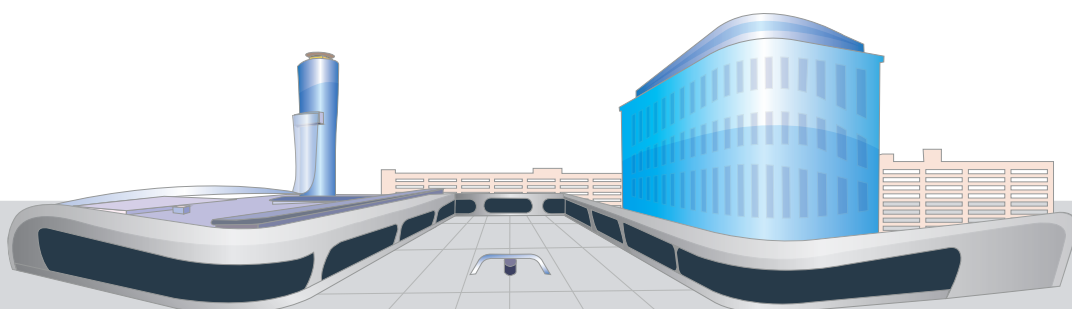

Events Entry Requirements for International Participants



Event attendance is granted for both vaccinated & non-vaccinated individuals



Requirements for International Participants

Both vaccinated & non-vaccinated individuals can attend shows in Abu Dhabi. The below steps are for vaccinated travellers to register their vaccination.

- 1 Register your arrival by logging into **ICA.gov.ae** when you plan your trip
- 2 Complete the registration arrival form
- 3 **No test** to fly to Abu Dhabi if you're fully vaccinated. If you are not fully vaccinated, you must present a negative PCR test result taken within **48 hours**, or a COVID19- recovery certificate.
- 4 Download **AlHosn app** and register your account using the UID that you received earlier and your phone number
- 5 You will receive an OTP to complete the registration on AlHosn App



VACCINATED VISITORS

- Present their vaccination certificate
- No longer need a test before you fly to Abu Dhabi.
- PCR test valid for no more than **96 hours** prior entrance to the event, and conducted in the UAE.
- **No quarantine is required**



NON-VACCINATED VISITORS

- Present their **passport and visa** as well at the entrance
- PCR test result taken within **48 hours**, or a COVID-19 recovery certificate to fly.
- PCR test valid for no more than **96 hours** to attending the event, and conducted in the UAE.
- **No quarantine is required**

Fully vaccinated individuals with over six months from their second dose must have a booster shot to retain their green status on the Al Hosn App.

Note: Vaccinated tourists will be allowed in public places limited to those vaccinated in Abu Dhabi per the approved process. They will be able to show their status through two ways: (1) register on Alhosn app to show their vaccination status and the results of tests done within the UAE, or (2) use the official app of their country of residence to show proof of vaccination and their phone to show test results.

FAQs

Q: NCEMA has issued an announcement that all event participants need to be vaccinated. Does this apply now?

A: No, vaccination is not a must. Instead, all participants must follow the new updated event entry requirements as clarified in the Department of Culture and Tourism [circular issued on 26/02/2022](#).

Q: What is the capacity of events, restaurants and weddings that currently apply in Abu Dhabi?

A: Events, restaurant and weddings in Abu Dhabi are operating at 90% capacity of the venue.

Q: If a participant arrives with an expired PCR test, what is the protocol in this case?

A: The participant will be denied access but directed to our on-site PCR testing facility to do a rapid PCR test at their own cost.

Q: Does ADNEC accept a DPI or lateral flow test result?

A: No, only negative PCR tests are accepted with 96 hours validity.

Q: What shall we do when we have a participant who feels unwell in the venue?

A: Please notify a member of ADNEC staff or security immediately on 800 23 632.

Q: How much does a PCR test cost at ADNEC?

A: The cost for the regular test is 40AED with the result relayed within 24 hours and fast track tests at 300 AED with results relayed within 4 hours.
