Its mission is to build and support a global network of universities and colleges to improve professional competencies in the prevention, treatment and applied research of SUDs and related conditions, and to increase access to quality.

Who we are

ICUDDR is a global consortium of universities that offer academic study programs focusing on science-based education in the prevention and treatment of substance use disorders. We were founded by a group of universities working together to develop and disseminate an international curriculum for substance use disorder prevention and treatment that is now available for any university to use.

Incorporated in the United States in March 2018, as of October 2022 we have 320 University Members in 80 different countries and territories across all regions of the world. We share the goal of improving outcomes for preventing and treating substance use problems by ensuring availability of a well-trained workforce through science-based curricula.




