In the modern world, substance use is a significant problem that can cause both physical and mental disorders. The availability of substances on the market, the increase in synthetic psychoactive substances and the low effectiveness of prevention programs pose a serious threat to the health of the nation. The creation of the ISSUP Youth Committee plays a fundamental role in solving this problem, especially given the geographical location of Kazakhstan and the proportion of young people among substance users.



### Aim:

To provide access for young people and adolescents to ethical, evidence-based prevention, harm reduction information, treatment and support in recovery when using substances. This will help create a healthy society in the future that does not need to seek out and use substances. Therefore, work should be done now by sharing knowledge and disseminating evidence-based prevention programs among young people.

The problem: School administrators usually doubt about students from medical universities, so there are problems with getting permisson on lectures

Solution: Organize meetings with school management, get to know each other and work together.

Key goal: Prevention in schools is aimed at young people at an early stage, before they develop attitudes or behavior towards substance use.






The problem: lack of space or platform for teenagers or young people to communicate.

Solution: Organization of summer schools, camps with a mandatory component of scientifically based prevention models. Creation of social networks, recording of podcasts and short videos.

Key goal: To unite young people and educate them so that they grow up resilient to substance use and can cope even in stressful situations.









Result: The Youth Committee won funding to implement a small project for young people in Astana.







# The main goal



The aim of this project is to implement the first stage of a multi-component program that will provide a wide range of anti-drug education in Astana, Kazakhstan.

The project is planned to be a <u>universal form of prevention</u>, so we have four main working directions of the projects:

- 1. Opening parenting classes
- 2. Trainings at schools for teens
- 3. Creating the board games "10 years ahead" with role- playing elements
- 4. Informing the general public via promoting account 'ISSUP Youth Committee in KZ' in Instagram



# -WHY A BOARD GAME?

educational purpose, not playability. We knew that it had to be engaging but that's not the main goal, the board game came to us as an idea that would be easier to introduce.

the idea must be highly effective because role-playing elements of the game improve skills such as decision-making, problem—solving, communicational skills and substance resistance skills.

entertaining characters and hypothetical scenarios would promote empathy amongst the players.

game format will create positive reinforcement for the children to make healthy choices.





# CONCEPT IDEA OF THE BOARD GAME



• Each stage can include an assessment of risk and vulnerability depending on the choices. If the student made the 'risky' choice within the framework of our topic, this does not mean that he has already lost. The student moves on to the next stage, where he can make a choice again. And so on, until he reaches the final stage (the options, accordingly, should be different there to show that each choice leads to its consequences or goals).
