- ❖ Huge population – Approx 279 Million (40% young people); (potential market)

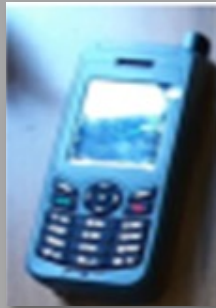

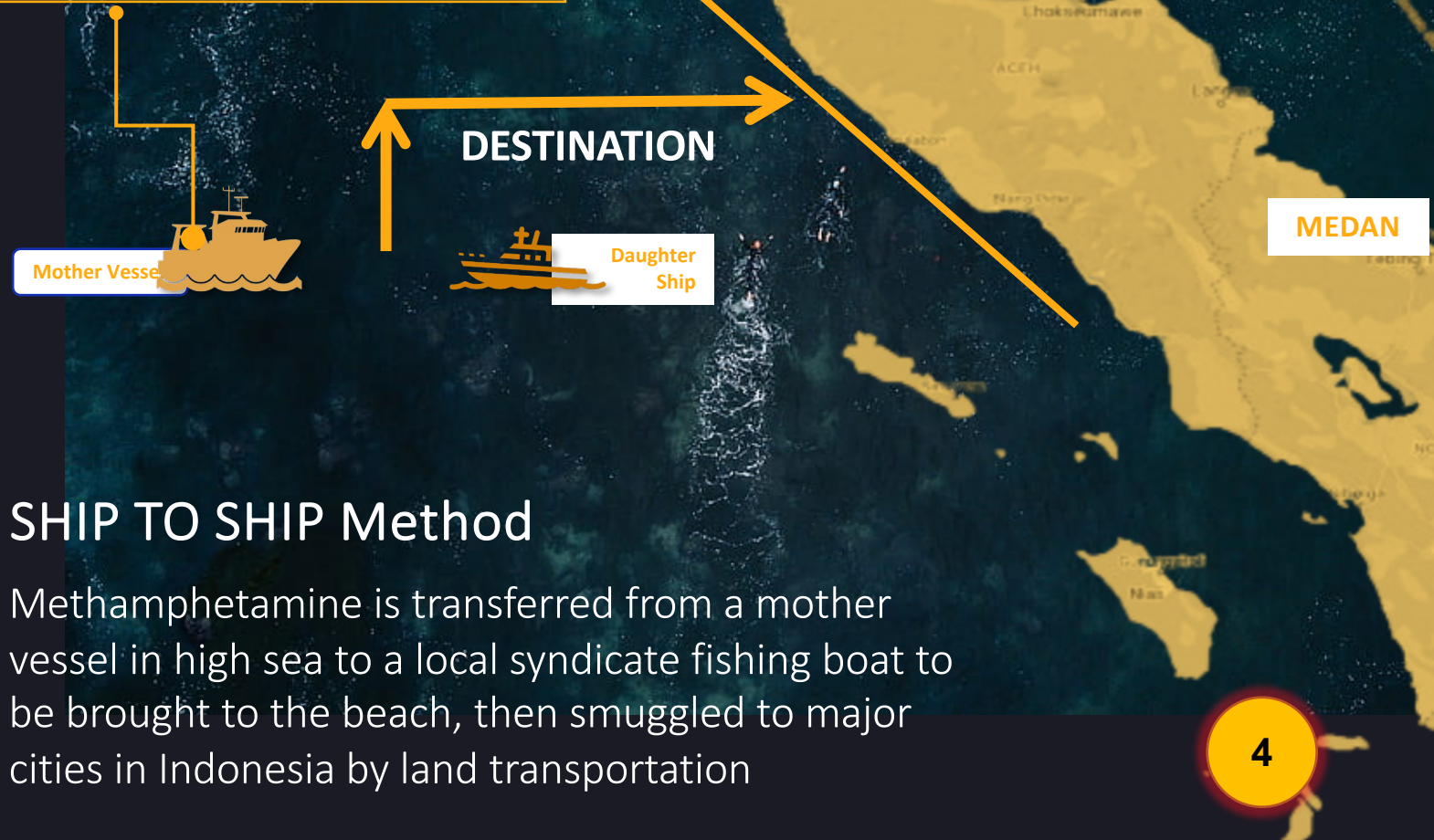

SHIP TO SHIP Method

Methamphetamine is transferred from a mother vessel in high sea to a local syndicate fishing boat to be brought to the beach, then smuggled to major cities in Indonesia by land transportation

Golden Triangle Meth Route

GOLDEN TRIANGLE

DTO: Chinese, Nigerian, Taiwanese, Malaysian, and Indonesian.

MO: Ship to ship, drug origin:

Route 1: Golden Triangle – Andaman Sea – Malaka Strait - Indonesia (Sumatera East Coast)

Route 2: Golden Triangle- Malaysia- Sumatera

Route 3: Golden Triangle- Sabah- South East Kalimantan- South Sulawesi

Indonesia was flooded by Meth from middle east because of the salient price difference, 286 US\$ per kg from middle east compared to 3,062 US\$ of Myanmar Meth.

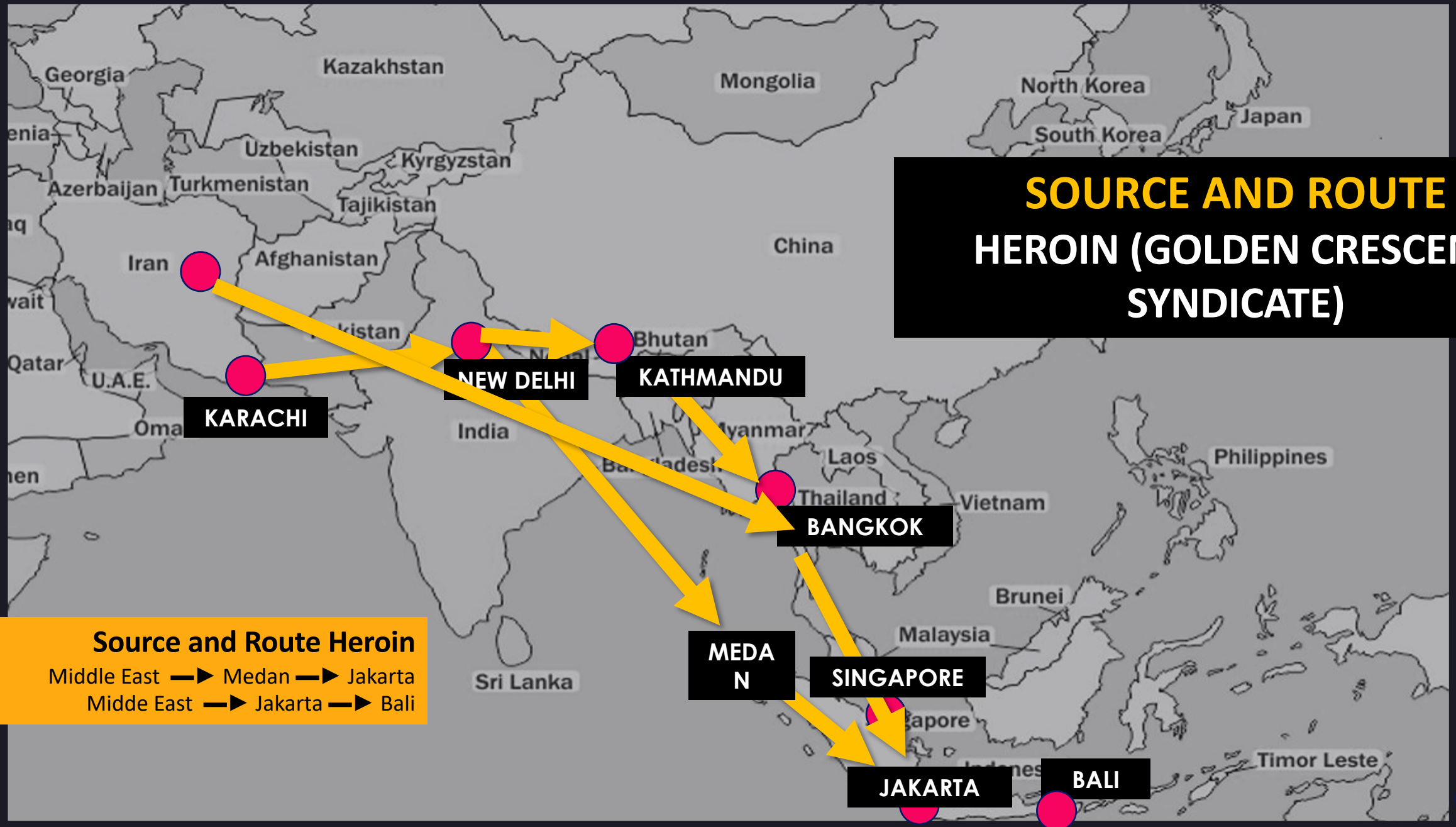

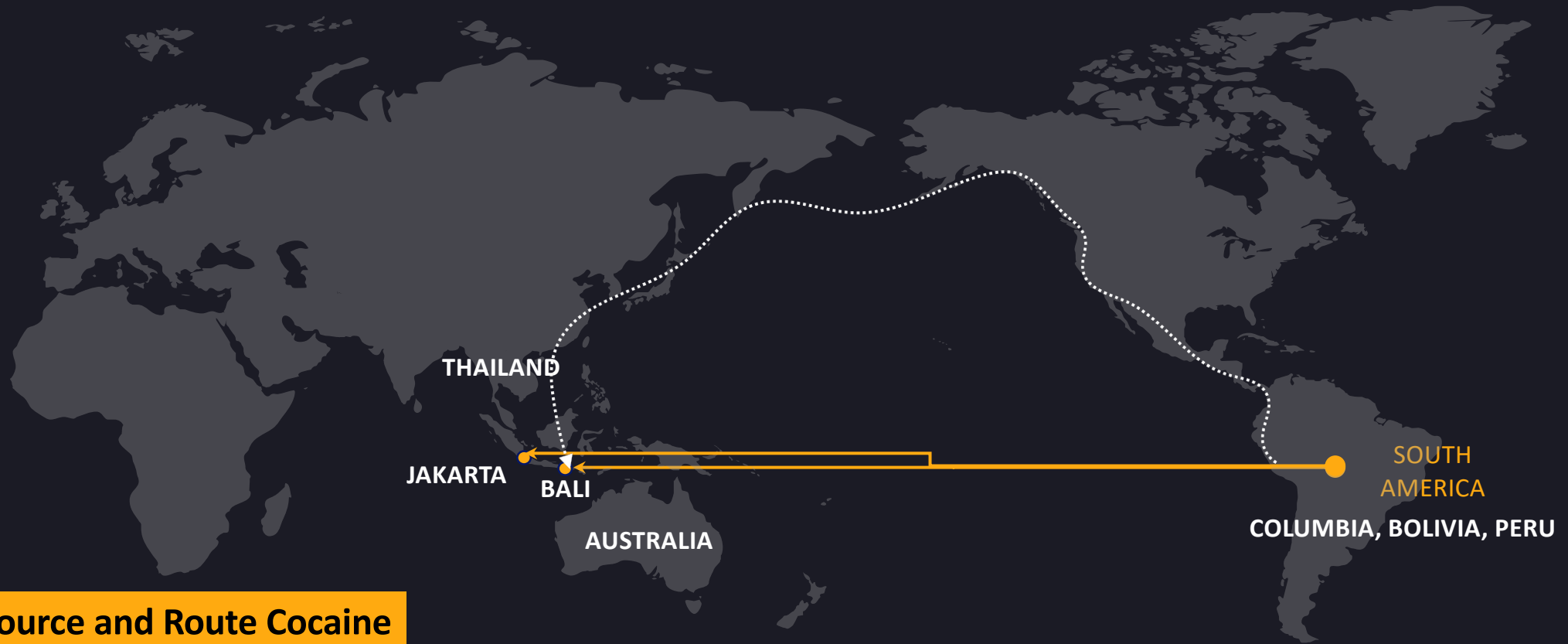

Illicit Drugs Trafficking Data

 Illicit drugs trafficking has been being a serious crime in Indonesia, every year, based on the **INP data on 2022 -2024 and first semester of 2025**, drug cases and evidences seized are still high.

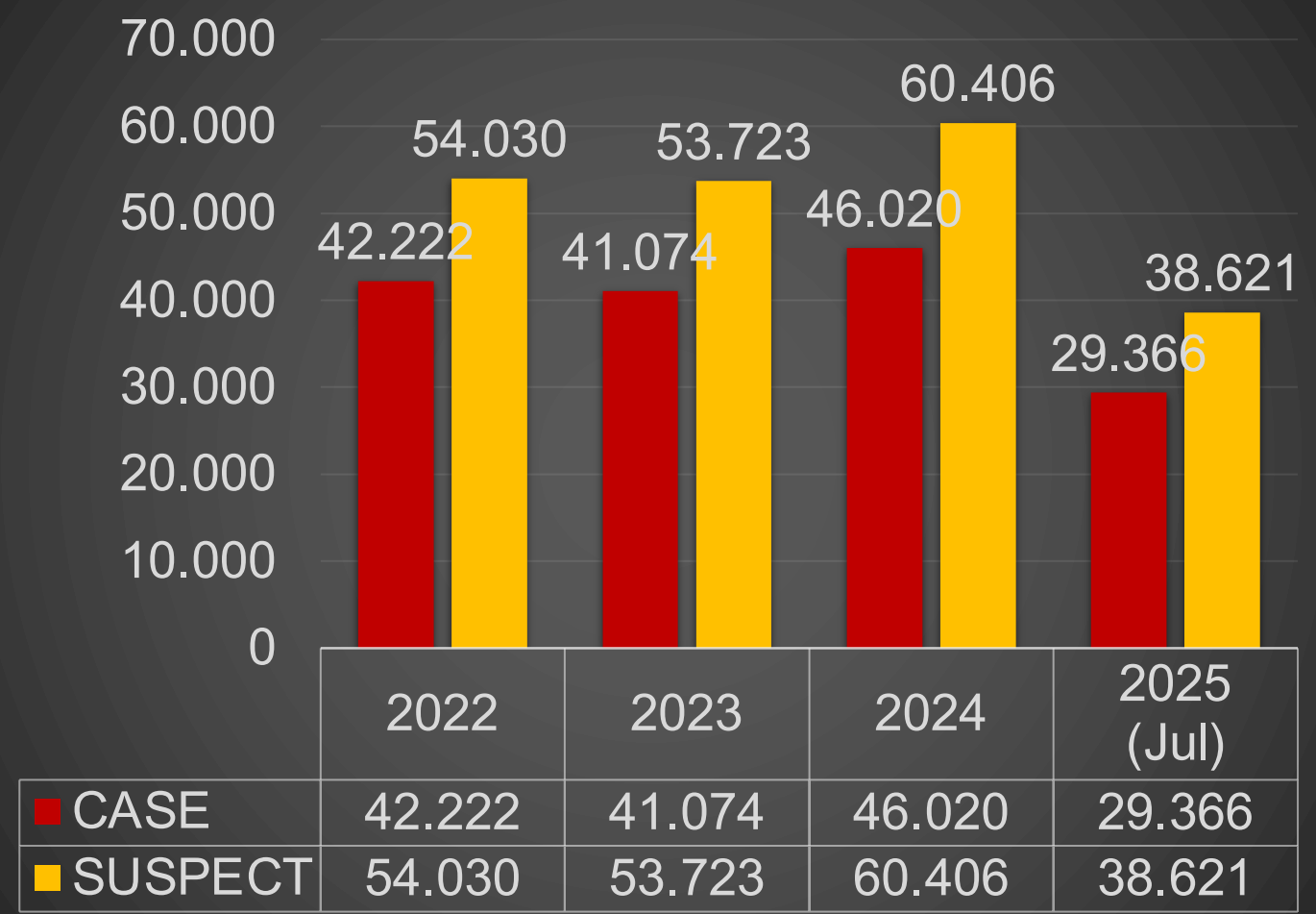
 Three types of drugs mostly abused are Meth, XTC and Cannabis.

 Meth problem is the biggest problem and also found some kinds of NPS.

 In the last three years, the methamphetamine seizure was still high, in 2021 Meth had been seized as much as 8.98 tons. And for 2022 was 6.51 tons, 2023 was 6.70 tons, as well as 2024 was 6,93 tons.

Prominent Cases on Clandestine Laboratory 2024



On April 4, 2024, on a joint operation with Customs, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP, successfully uncovered an Ecstasy clandestine laboratory at Sunter North Jakarta.

Four suspects arrested by the evidence of 7.800 tablets of Ecstasy along with chemical precursor, laboratory equipment and punch dies.

Advanced investigation on the suspects, then known that the cland lab was arranged and controlled by Fredy Pratama.

Prominent Cases on Clandestine Laboratory 2024



On April 3, 2024, on a joint operation, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP, Directorate of Drugs Investigation of Central Java Reg. Police and Indonesian Customs uncovered clandestine labs. at Semarang Central Java province, two Indonesian nationals arrested by the evidence in total of 2,000 ml of Happy Water containing MDMA in several sachet with different logos , along with various precursors and lab equipment.



On May 2, 2024, on a joint operation, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP, Directorate of Drugs Investigation of Bali Regional Police and Indonesian Customs, successfully uncovered a clandestine lab. at Badung Bali province. Two Ukrainians, a Russian and an Indonesian male arrested by the the evidence of 10,2 kg of Cannabis, 108 gr of Cocainne, 485 gr of Hashis and 684 gr Mephedrone along with precursors and lab equipment.



On June 14, 2024, on a joint operation, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP and Directorate of Drugs Investigation of North Sumatera Regional Police, successfully uncovered a clandestine lab. at Medan, North Sumatera, 5 Indonesian nationals arrested by the evidence of 635 tablets of XTC and 532.92 gr of Mephedrone along with precursors and lab equipment.



On July 1, 2024, on a joint operation with Customs, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP, successfully uncovered a clandestine lab at Malang East Java.

Five suspects arrested by the evidence of 1.2 ton of synthetic cannabinoid (tobacco), 25.000 tablets of Ecstasy and 25.000 tablets of Xanax along with chemical precursor, laboratory equipment and punch dies.

of 40 kg of
Methamphetamine and a

Jaya Regional Police
successfully uncovered an
illicit drug trafficking
syndicate at Medan North
Sumatera province.

On February 3, 2025, on a joint operation, Directorate of Drugs Investigation of Bali Regional Police and Customs, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at I Gusti Ngurah Rai international airport.

Two British nationals named . Jonathan Christoper Collyer and Lisa Ellen Stocker arrested by the evidence of 1,080 gr of Cocainne.



On Februari 8, 2025, on a joint operation, Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement CIB INP and Indonesian Customs, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at Lhoksemawe Aceh province.

Four Indonesian suspects arrested by the evidence of 135 kg of Methamphetamine and a fishing boat.



On February 25, 2025, on a joint operation, Indonesian navy and Directorate of Drugs Investigation of Kepri Regional Police, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at Tanjung Batu waters Kepri.

Three Indonesian suspects arrested by the evidence of 60,000 tablets of Ecstasy.



On February 25, 2025, on a joint operation, INP and Indonesian Customs, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at Aceh Tamiang Aceh.

An Indonesian suspect arrested by the evidence of 188 kg of Methamphetamine.



On April 8, 2025, on a joint operation, INP and Indonesian Customs, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at Bireuen Aceh.

An Indonesian suspect arrested by the evidence of 192 kg of Methamphetamine.



International cooperation

- a. The Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement (CIB INP) conducts cooperation with relevant agencies such as the Financial Transaction Reports and Analysis Center (PPATK), Immigration, Customs, NNB, as well as with drug law enforcement agencies from other countries such as the US DEA (United States of America), Royal Thai Police, ONCB Thailand, Royal Malaysian Police, and the AFP (Australian Federal Police);
- b. The Directorate of Drugs Law Enforcement (CIB INP) participates actively in bilateral meetings, regional and international forums related to the eradication of drug crimes.

On May 4, 2025, on a joint operation, INP and Indonesian Customs, successfully uncovered an illicit drug trafficking syndicate at Langsa Aceh.

An Indonesian suspects arrested by the evidence of 99 kg of Methamphetamine.
